

# Moving Tips

## to Save Time and Money



- Try to consolidate all small items into boxes. (Very big time saver!)
- At the pickup location, place all boxes in one area and out of the way.
- Clear all hallways, stairs and entrances.
- Securely tape your boxes shut. Also, please do not pack them too heavy. If two men have to carry a single box, you are losing time and money.
- Label boxes as to where they should be placed in your new home.
- Leave your phone connected throughout the day of your move. Cellular phones are great for moving days. If you have one, please let us know the number. If the movers are running behind schedule, we can contact you.
- If possible, reserve a parking spot for the truck.
- Drain waterbeds.
- Empty and defrost all refrigerators and freezers.
- Drawers may remain intact as long as they contain nothing heavy or breakable.
- Disassemble anything required such as bunk beds, stoves, dryers, washers, etc. This is not required, however it will save time. Movers are not allowed to reconnect gas connection.
- Designate one person to direct movers at the drop-off location. Also, have one person available at all times to answer questions and make decisions for the move.
- Empty gas tanks of lawn mowers, snow blowers, etc.
- Keep pets and children out of the way of movers.
