

Terms of Service Contract



When value of shipment or released value of the entire lot or specific articles names exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, appropriate insurance to cover the excess value, when requested by the shipper, will be arranged for by the carrier at shipper's expense, and the charges therefore shall be added to the bill for transportation and any other lawful charges.

Articles of High or Extraordinary Value

The carrier may refuse to accept for shipment, except at owner's risk, articles of jewelry, money, deeds, notes or other valuable paper, postage or revenue stamps, precious metals, stones or articles manufactured there from, or other articles of extraordinary value.

Dangerous Articles

Explosives, acids or other dangerous or corrosive substances or articles of an offensive nature, which may cause damage to property or to the carrier's equipment, shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

Limitation of Size and Weight

All shipments shall be subject to the requirements of ordinances or laws limiting or regulating the transportation of property or the use of vehicles and facilities.

Payment of Charges

The carrier shall not deliver or relinquish possession of any property transported by it until all tariff rates and charges thereon have been paid except when arrangements have been made prior to or at the time the shipment is accepted for transportation. Nothing herein shall limit the right of the carrier to require before the transportation is performed the prepayment in part or in full or a guarantee of the charges.

Claims

All claims shall be made in writing and shall be accompanied by the paid freight bill or bill of lading, if not previously surrendered to the carrier. The carrier shall be immediately notified of all claims for concealed damages and shall be given reasonable opportunity to inspect alleged concealed damage in the original package.

Application of Rates

The hourly rates published herein for local moving shall apply to:

- a) The job time required in removing goods and loading on vehicle at premises from which goods are moved, in transportation between premises, and in unloading and placing goods at premises to which the goods are moved; and
- b) Actual driving time required in driving from carrier's office or garage to shipper's premises to start job and from shipper's premises to carrier's office or garage after completion of job, but not less than thirty (30) minutes each way within the county of Milwaukee.
- c) Computation of charges for fractional parts of an hour: Charges for fractional parts of an hour shall be computed by adding one-quarter of the hourly charges for each fifteen (15) minute period or fraction thereof.

Minimum Charges

The minimum charge for local moving at hourly rates shall be the charge for one hour according to the number of men employed on the job plus travel time.
